COMMUNITY MATTERS

1. SURVEY: The survey process has begun but not the actual property delineations. No timeline to report, but Shelly did mention that 3-4 meetings with Cottagers will need to occur as the survey process gets underway.

2. UNDERGROUNDING: The undergrounding process is expected to begin in May at the western perimeter of the Chautauqua boundary along Bluebell Rd. Phase 1, beginning along the north side of Morning Glory and moving to the north will start in the early fall.

3. DINING HALL: As per the agreement with the Dining Hall operators, the Dining Hall management is responsible for interior needs/renovations. Chautauqua is responsible for the outside. Because of wood rot in the staircase leading up to the entrance of the Dining Hall, the Dining Hall operators asked that CCA replace the stairs.

4. GALEY: We have received several questions about the landscape construction in front of the Galey cottage. We are seeking answers and will send an update as soon as we have it.
